President Darren Douma's opening statement, mainly consisted of thank you's to all pertinent parties. Including the Pro-Shop and its personnel, the ground keeping crew, club house employees, all Men's League sponsors, the Men's League Board of Directors and all Members.

Men's Club Captain David Magrum's statement was as follows

Men's Night/League Scoring

Your scores entered need to be the actual number of shots you took on each hole, not the maximum your handicap allows. Men's Night/League scoring is adjusted when the next weeks handicaps are calculated.

Sunday Morning Play

Games will stay the same with modifications for player participation.

Match Play

The single knock out format worked well this year. Any suggestions for improvement will be considered. Please submit to the Men's Club Executive in writing before the end of the golf season.

Kootenay Cup

Change the qualifying to Net scores only NO Gross scores. This reasoning is the Kootenay Cup is played as Net. Qualifying days will be 2 Sundays and the Wednesday between the 2 Sundays for a total of 3 qualifying days. You can pay to qualify on any or all of these days but only once per day. Your best score will be used. Ties will be decided by retrogression.

At this time NO changes to the current selection process as published on the members Web Site.

Men's League Wednesday Play

Keep scoring 4 places per team. The majority of the feedback that I have received has been positive. If a team only gets 3 members playing the 4th score will be the lowest score posted of all players for that day. This way a team is not taken out of the competition by a poor showing that may be out of their control.

Men's League Scramble

For KP's if a team scores an eagle on a birdie hole 2 additional points will be awarded. Proposed changes in the points value for scrambles now that we are counting the scores for 4 members of the team.

1st Scenario

No changes.

All scrambles 50 points for 1st place with decreasing points by 2 points for 2nd place through 4th place, then decrease by 1 point through 11th place with 2 points for KP's. In the current format the max points is 68 and min is 36 points. (32 points difference.)

2nd Scenario

All scrambles 100 points for 1st place with decreasing points by 2 through 11th place and 2 points for KP's.

3rd Scenario

1st Scramble 50 points for 1st place with decreasing points by 2 through 11th place and 2 points for KP's.

2nd Scramble end of 1st half 100 points for 1st place with decreasing points by 2 through 11th place and 2 points for KP's.

3rd Scramble start of 2nd half 100 points for 1st place with decreasing points by 2 through 11th place and 3 points for KP's.

4th Scramble end of season 150 points for 1st place with decreasing points by 2 through 11th place and 3 points for KP's. In this format the max points is 177 and a min of 130 points. (47 points difference.)

I favor Scenario #3. This can be revisited at the end of next year and can always be changed or modified if it is not achieving the desired result.

_____ end of Dave statement.

There were numerous discussions regarding the point system of the 4 annual scrambles, and the scenarios put forward by Dave Magrum as well as the number of teams in the Men's League.

The majority of the attendees seem to favour 10 teams if it would mean 10 players per team.

Decision was made to tentatively adhere to 10 teams, based on the number of players available. Possibly add one more team if there are enough players signed by the time the draft is held.

Ken Karlander brought up the issue of members added to teams after the draft. He suggested that only NEW members should be allowed to be added after the draft is held

The board decided to send out a "plebiscite like" email in the spring to all members, with 3 different scenarios regarding the scrambles and its point system. And make a decision based on what most members are in favour of.

David Magrum made a motion to adjourn the meeting.
