Treasurer's Report

Approval of Financial Report/Next Year's Budget-Motion by Ted Moffat Seconded Don V.
CARRIED

Dining Room Certificates- Ted brought up concerns with these certificates. Consensus was to leave as is. (\$20.00)

Distribution of Power Numbers

Ted provided statistical numbers from Men's League results. Discussion about whether to post these numbers on the member's sit was discussed. It was agreed not to post and to only provide these numbers to team captains during the draft night.

Distribution of Pay-out statistics

Ted provided a breakdown of payouts to all participants and how much these participants paid into men's night. A concern was that we may lose high handicap's participation because the figures were favoring the lower handicap players. After much discussion it was agreed upon that we reduce the number of gross payouts from 3 to 2 per flight. Monies from the third gross would be distributed in the net categories. **Motion** Ted M Seconded By David Magrum
CARRIED.

Additional Discussions arising from Roles and Responsibilities

Men's League

Much discussion went on about the player's power numbers and the average points per player. It was discussed to count 4 players per league team versus 3 players per league team. This was considered a few years ago, but was not agreed upon.

Motion made by **Kurt Chenuz** to review making the change from 3 players to 4. Ted M to provide numbers based on this change. **Seconded** by David Magrum CARRIED

Men's League Discussion CONT.....

Ted M also made a **motion** that Men's League sponsorship be increased from \$175 to \$200. There has not been an increase in many years and the increase would make book-keeping easier as well.

Seconded By Don V. **CARRIED**

It was noted that we need to do a better job of promoting Men's League to our members.

Darren had a concern with having two men's league scrambles in the same month of July. Darren made the **motion** to move one of the scrambles to August. After discussion it was agreed to have the third scramble in August (9th) running it on the Back-9. **Seconded** by David Magrum. **CARRIED**

Recognizing our Sponsors more:

Darren suggested that like what was done in the past should be done again. This was recognizing one sponsor per week on the first tee. Signage would need to be provided. **Darren to work on.**

Discussion on the "OLD" white board was discussed as well. Brian suggested that we look into getting another board and placing on the first tee each Wednesday. This board would display all current men's league results like done in the clubhouse in the past. **Darren to investigate**

SMART TV/Promotion of club events, Men's League results, our sponsors, etc.

Darren had investigated software for the TV, which costs \$5000-\$8,000. Don V indicated this was investigated before. It's agreed by all to look at cheaper alternatives. **Darren to put something together.** Communication with Doug Vance recommended as well. We want to ensure our sponsors are getting recognized more, so we need to see what we can do to promote them on the SMART TV. **Kurt will assist Darren as needed.**

Match Play

Much discussion on the best way to structure the 2017 Match play in order to get the most participation, completion dates, handicapping, etc.

The results from this discussion determined:

- NO qualifying round
- NO consolation round
- Stringent completion dates- if players don't complete matches on time, the winner of a match will be determined by a coin toss performed by Club Captain David Magrum and/or Kurt Chenuz
- Handicapped (100%) ***this was to be confirmed by reviewing the latest RCGA match play rules.
- Confirm the best seeding process
- Entry Fee: \$20
- Promotion: Do a better job of promoting early and how the match play will be run. This will hopefully generate interest and participation.

- Ted and Brian already established a preliminary budget based on the average amount of entries.
- E.g. Winner receives a jacket and \$250.00 in Pro Shop Credit Additional pay-outs will be runner-up position and semi-finalist position.
- Need all participants to provide their phone numbers so players can contact each other to set up their matches. Also need to provide and post the rules of the match play. Especially meeting the completion dates of matches AND players posting the results of their match on the sheet.
